Maternity services boosted with the appointment of a new specialist

Women receiving maternity care in Lincoln and Gainsborough are benefitting from the expertise of a new specialist consultant.

Consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist Vandana Agarwal was recently appointed to Lincoln County Hospital.

Miss Agarwal's specialities lay in fetal scanning and prenatal diagnosis of abnormalities.

Miss Agarwal completed her undergraduate training in India, before moving to the UK to undertake postgraduate training in obstetrics and gynaecology at West Midlands Deanery. She received accreditation from the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists in 2003.

During specialist training, Miss Agarwal worked in rotation across hospitals in Staffordshire, Shrewsbury and Wolverhampton.

Miss Agarwal then went on to work as a substantive consultant at the University Hospital of North Staffordshire for eight months, before joining Lincoln County Hospital.

Additional to her duties at Lincoln County Hospital, Miss Agarwal's remit will include running some clinics in Gainsborough.

Miss Agarwal said: "I joined Lincoln County Hospital to provide strong professional leadership for the labour ward, so that we can maintain and develop the high standard of maternity care provided. I aim to achieve this with the support of the exceptional consultant team and maternity staff here."
